Course Description/ Instructor Info:

Taught by **Steve Lively**, recording artist, soloist and Living Proof choir director, this course is designed to give everyone a chance to sing! This is the perfect opportunity to try something new & different in a safe and non-threatening learning environment. Special permission has been given to APS students to join the 100+ member high school & college choir from Grace Baptist Church (GBC). This choir practices on Saturday afternoons, performs occasionally at services, delivers an incredible Christmas extravaganza and goes on tour in the spring. In addition to this, the APS students will meet exclusively with Mr. Lively on Thursdays (at GBC) for 1½ hours to practice special pieces chosen just for our group. This group may perform in festivals and at APS events.

APS high school students DO NOT have to audition for the choir or ensemble. Individual evaluations will be made to determine parts the students will learn. Mr. Lively will also include 1 hour of individual coaching during the year. (This alone is a great value!) Grades will be based on participation, effort and growth, not talent!

Cost per semester: \$125

Materials fee per semester: \$40

(Additional fees will apply to tour and some special choir events)

Min. number of students: 8

*APS H.S. Co-op courses are normally limited to students in grades 9 – 12; however,

mature 8th grade students may be considered for choir!

Students in 8th grade **must audition** for Mr. Lively.

Students in 8th grade who are admitted to the APS Choir will **not be a part of** the *Living Proof* choir. Their participation in only the APS Choir will not justify standard units; therefore, this will be an extra-curricular activity for 8th grade students. Students in 8th grade will NOT receive units for APS Choir.

This is a two semester course that is worth a combined total 5 units. A grade will only be given at the end of the year.

Choir - Registration Form

The cost of this course involves a **Course Fee**, **Materials Fee**, and **Co-op Fees**.

Checks for all three must be submitted with your registration (reg) form.

Though most people make full payment at time of registration, APS allows installment payment checks. You may pay in full, in 2 installments or in 4 installments.

ALL installment payment checks MUST BE INCLUDED with your registration form.

2. Payment of Materials Fees for the year: MAKE PAYABLE TO STEVE LIVELY

- 1 ck. in the amt of \$80 due @ time of reg. **or**
- 2 cks. in the amt of \$40 due @ time of reg.
Make one dated reg-date and the other dated 11/1/06
(Additional fees will apply to tour and some special choir events)

3. Payment of Co-op Fees for the year: MAKE PAYABLE TO "CASH"

- 1 ck. in the amt of \$16 due @ time of reg. **or**
- 2 cks. in the amt of \$ 8 due @ time of reg.
Make one dated reg-date and the other dated 11/1/06
