Grade: 9-12

Course Description:

World History is a course designed for students to study the story of human historical events in our modern-day world. Students will not only learn about people, places, and events, but they will also use high-level thinking skills to analyze the impact of events from a Christian perspective. Goals of this course include:

- To recognize key periods and people throughout history and evaluate their impact on the world at large.

- To compare and contrast events from different perspectives.
- To evaluate events from a Christian point of view.
- To learn effective note taking skills.
- To write complete/concise essays and present them to the class.
